- 3.5.4.3. **SUGGESTIONS:** if make the seminar campus wide, can charge a \$5 admission fee, reaching out to UBC sororities and UBC Central, PhUS minor initiatives fund

- 3.5.4.5. <u>IDEA</u>: Would be nice to have a more pharmacy focused aspect to the talk, especially if doing the seminar as part of PAM. We can have Marni speak for an hour, and have a pharmacist knowledgeable about transgender and LGBQ+ community speak after
