4.1. Competitions follow-up, 7 min.

4.1.1. C.Ma: Feedback: Separating fb pages for each competition. How was that?

S.Burke: Liked it. Thought it was easier to navigate. Participation was low; how do we promote it?

J.Alam: Some people didn't know what these competitions were about.

N.Le: Timing is an issue. We are holding a lot of events later in the term, which makes it difficult for people to participate.

J.Curl: Start advertising early. Instead of Facebook posts, we could send a newsletter for CAPSI members. C.Ma: We have a newsletter, but we don't send it on a monthly basis.

C.Giovanatti: We need to highlight the prizes. Timing is an issue; NTP at the end of the semester was not the best idea.

C.Ma: For next year, we should go over the competitions at the beginning of the year when people are not busy. Putting examples; confirm with winners if it is ok to use them as examples.

S.Burke: In-class announcements could be helpful. FB posts are so long, and people don't usually read the whole post.

J.Curl: Agrees that in-class announcements are better to promote events.

A.Grewal: We should send a mass email to members to promote competitions. We should also promote on Instagram as well.

4.2. <u>Attendance Promotion Initiative.</u> (J.Curl)

4.2.1. CAPSI UAlberta mentioned that they split their CAPSI members into teams and award points for attendance to CAPSI/IPSF events. At the end of the year, they give awards to the team or person with the most points. This might be a good idea to promote attendance to our events, form a sense of community between CAPSI members and increase the number of members.

Similar to Houses of Hogwarts. Maybe we could start it next semester or next year?

4.2.2. S.Burke: Likes the idea. People don't even know if they're CAPSI members. Someone would have to be responsible for the whole idea and it could be a lot of work/

C.Ma: Good idea. We should have enough in our budget. Should we give out badges or stickers? Stickers are cheaper. They don't have to be CAPSI related.

J.Curl: Whoever is holding an event can keep track of who shows up. We could split CAPSI executives and share responsibilities.

C.Ma: We have about 150 members. Maybe it would be easier to target individuals or small teams.

C.Ma: Teams of 2 could be considered. SOC is not long enough. NTP would be fun and more engaging but the winners would go to National to compete; we don't have enough money.

N.Le: Compounding Competition is a group competition. C.Ma: Pharmafacts is also a competition for a team of 4.
